Lessons in the mornings are with our experienced team of teachers, they understand the challenges of learning French and are able to instill confidence in students as well as helping them overcome mental blocks and bring a sense of purpose to students learning.

The afternoon activities are in partnership with **ESF** and **Evolution 2**, leaders in outdoor activities for children. All the instructors are French-speaking.

*Students can also opt for our **Mornings only** option and leave camp at 12.30 after their French lessons.

What to pack ?

Key items

- Factor 50 suncream
- A hat or cap
- Sunglasses
- snacks
- water bottles

For lessons

A pencil case including:

- Pens, pencils, sharpener, highlighter, rubber, glue, scissors, ruler...
- Small dictionary FR-EN (optional)

Please do not bring valuable items to Camp. If possible, please label your child's clothes with their name.

- For the activities

- Comfy clothes suitable for activities (that can get dirty or wet)
- A swimming costume suitable for swimming pools
- A jumper or fleece depending on the weather conditions
- A water bottle, snacks, and a picnic lunch
- A waterproof jacket
- Plenty of snacks and water bottle
- Trainers or walking shoes, including a pair for water activities (that can get dirty or wet)



Code of Conduct



Juniors agree to:

- Make an effort to communicate in French where and when possible.
- Ensure that they have understood, and to ask for help or for the speaker to repeat, explain and translate if necessary.
- Respect the timetable of the Summer Camp, lesson or activities.
- Respect the staff, the teachers and activity Leaders and their fellow classmates.
- Respect the environment (buildings, equipment and materials).
- Behave in a polite and courteous manner with people from outside the centre.
- Respect all safety regulations at all times.
- Use electronic devices (mobile phone) reasonably during free time and according to the instructions of our Staff.
- Swearing / Offensive language and inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated
- Bullying will not be tolerated

Legal Requirements

The following are strictly forbidden:

- The consumption of alcohol, smoking or using banned substances.
- Bringing the above products onto any of the Alpine French School's premises.
- Visit websites not suitable for under **18s**.
- Violence, sexual harassment, racism and all other forms of discrimination.

Protocol in the event of a breach of the Code of Conduct

- 1 - The Camp Management Team will evaluate the situation.
- 2 - The Camp Management Team will take the necessary measures to resolve the situation. In some cases, we withhold the right to exclude students for example: when a situation or behavior impacts other students or staff members
- 3 - In the event of an exclusion, all costs forthwith, are at the expense of the parents or guardians of the Junior.

Medical Information



Supervision

Our team is very attentive to all aspects of the well-being of our juniors, including, but not limited to, their safety, their integration and their feelings.

Our team is present to supervise, guide and help your child.

Insurance

You must take out an insurance policy which covers the duration of the stay of your child, from arrival to departure at the camp and outside of the camp.

Allergies and Medical Conditions

It is absolutely necessary to communicate any allergies or medical conditions prior to the arrival of your child, however minor they may be.

Vaccines

We strongly recommend that juniors are up to date with their vaccinations.

Medications Policy

If your child requires medication or help with a medical condition, please inform our team before arrival and they will be happy to help.

How To Book

1. Send us an enquiry via our website, email or call us
2. Complete a **'Junior Enrolment Form'** - one per each child that you would like to enrol for our camp
3. On the **Junior Enrolment Form**, make sure you provide as much information as possible, to save time in the future. This includes: date of birth, medical conditions or allergies, any prior French learning experience and (if taking activities) the height of your child.
4. Once we've received your enrolment form, we will send you a quote within **48 hours** with a deposit amount, this is **25% of the total amount of the booking**.
5. Pay your deposit through one of our 3 easy payment methods!
6. We'll send you a confirmation email once we've received your deposit, then a full payment will be required **6 weeks** before the camp start date.
