Parental permission for students under 18 years old

It is important for Alpine French School to specify that any student under the age of 18 is considered to be a minor. This is due to legal restrictions regarding what is and isn't acceptable to minors.

Alpine French School will accept students as young as 16 years old for their adult courses, but it is important for them to be aware that parental permission is compulsory.

We understand that this is not thecase in all countries, but this decision is made in order to protect the best we can the safety and well-being of our students. This is also a requirement of various Quality Language Services that we like to comply with.

Conditions relating to under 18 year-old students

The following rules and conditions are designed for the well-being and protection of our younger students.

Going out at night

Morzine is a very safe mountain village and we encourage all our students to make the most of what the town has to offer, including for under-age students, providing they do not drink alcoholic beverages in bars and restaurants (see below).

General curfew is fixed at 11 pm and we ask students to respect the general house rules upon return (respect your flatmates and their routine, no drunk/disorderly behaviour...). It's important to signal to your host family where you are going, who with and what time you are expected back. Your host family remains the decision-maker when it comes to your curfew and they have the right to impose an earlier curfew if they choose to do so.

These are general guidelines for the host family and the students but we encourage both parties to discuss the best arrangements to get the best experience on both sides.

If the general code of conduct is not respected and the host family reports an abuse of behaviour, this may result in disciplinary action and Alpine French School reserves the right to ask the student to leave the school with no right of refund. Parents/guardian will be informed of the situation in order to discuss the outcome.

Alcoholic drinks, tobacco and drugs

It is important to know that the alcohol age limit in bars and restaurant in France is 18 years old and we ask our under-age students to respect this so as not to impact on either the school or the host family. Drinking alcohol with your host family is at their discretion and if allowed this should be in moderation (French families may offer a small glass of wine with dinner for example).

Smoking tobacco is at the student's discretion, and must be discussed and agreed with the host family. The age limit for cigarette purchase in France is 16 years old.

Regarding drug possession and consumption, Alpine French School have a zero tolerance policy and this will result in disciplinary action. We also want to draw your attention to the fact that French police take a tough line with regards to this.

Problems related to either of these situations could result in a disciplinary action. Alpine French School reserves the right to ask the student to leave the school with no right of refund. Parents/ guardian will be informed of the situation in due course and in order to discuss the outcome. In the event of the student being expelled, the parent/ guardian will be responsible for any extra costs (such as airport transfers, earlier return flights...).

Attendance and academic rules

In order to ensure the smooth progress of the course, we ask all our students to follow certain rules :

- Students MUST attend all classes. In the event that they cannot attend (sickness, delay..) they must contact the school asap.
- Students must be punctual
- Students must dedicate the appropriate amount of time to the given homework

Failure to follow these regulations could impact on the student's progress and result in being placed in a lower class, not receiving a certificate of attendance or in extreme cases, being asked to leave without the right of refund.
